

Sally Foster:	this is WES PTA's kickoff fall fundraiser selling gift wrap, cookie dough and assorted gift items
Sally Foster donation:	these are direct donations from folks who do not buy the product but want to contribute financially
Other fall fundraiser:	these determined on a yearly basis and vary
Book fair:	this is a scholastic book fair and sales; occurs twice a year
Flower sale:	happens at the spring fair; live flowers/plants are sold
Super market receipts:	Snider's gives us a percentage of their sales yearly for ALL the receipts we turn in. We register our Giant and Safeway savings cards and proceeds go to WES PTA
Donations from members:	100% for WES PTA
Spirit wear:	sales of WES Wizards logoed t-shirts, sweat shirts, magnets etc.
Dine out nights:	local restaurants give a kickback for PTA members dining there on a specified night
Winter festival:	coincides with the auction; book sales, jewelry sale, kids activities
Auction:	silent auction
Spring fair raffle:	benefits a tech fund for the school; local goods and services are given away
ICB:	county office that allocates all county spaces for use past normal operating hours and charges accordingly for staff to man any use
Scholarships:	monies provided to allow financially challenged families to enroll their children in after school clubs
After school clubs:	ANY clubs the PTA decides to run after school. They include academic clubs, as well as "fun" clubs taught by Woodlin teachers, parents, and outside organizations
Cooking supplies:	funds provided to the cooking teacher to offset costs to run this class
After school clubs stipends:	stipends to WES staff that teach after school clubs
Activity buses:	transportation from after school clubs to designated bus stops
Club Coordinator:	WES staff member who supervises clubs on-site and manages dismissal from clubs

Geo Bee:	geography competition, 3rd-5th graders, not unlike a spelling bee
Math night:	an evening of fun math activities, which typically follows a short PTA meeting

Cultural arts assemblies:	events that occur during school hours that expose the kids to things like dance, theatre, art etc
Grade level projects:	monies for each grade level K-5 and LFI (Life for Independence) to supplement things like projects, field trips etc
Kindergarten orientation:	balloons and decorations for K orientation day
Safety patrol training:	training for the 4/5 graders that help the younger kids get to their buses and to their classes
Classroom support:	\$75 to each teacher for incentives for the children and misc items for their rooms outside D of E guidelines
Open house hospitality:	boxed lunches and ice pops for the open house
Spring fair:	annual fun fair with music, rides, food etc
International night:	food and fun from around the globe
Black history month:	various activities related to Black history
Hispanic heritage month:	various activities related to Hispanic history including a potluck
Teacher/staff appreciation:	breakfast/luncheons for WES staff members
Movie night:	outdoor movie with pizza and snacks
Woodlin dance:	social event
Outreach:	any activities related to further inclusion of the varied groups at WES
Costume Closet:	costumes to borrow for the annual Halloween parade for any children that need them
School directory:	contact info for parents/students of WES
PTA meeting babysitting:	2 sitters provided for each general meeting
Sitter supplies:	crayons/markers/activity books etc for use by PTA sitters during PTA meetings

PTA meeting hospitality: pizza and water provided for all PTA meetings

PTA appreciation: departing gifts for long term or exceptional volunteers and 5th grade parent volunteers (usually flowers and/or gift cards)

Charitable org. update fee: fee paid to state to register our PTA as a non-profit

Training/subscriptions/dues: executive board expenses

MCCPTA Pres/Principals dinner: Mont. County Council PTA dinner/meeting

Woodlin Musicians Fund: private donations to support WES' instrumental music program
